

PVEC Welcomes The Rev. Elizabeth W. Myers

The congregation of the Panther Valley Ecumenical Church welcomed The Rev. Elizabeth W. Myers following her first Worship Service at the church on January 6, 2008. Rev. Myers will serve as “Interim” pastor for the next six months.

PVEC is an Ecumenical Church founded in 1969 by The Presbyterian Church, USA, The Episcopal Church, The United Church of Christ, The United Methodist Church, and The Covenant Ecumenical Community. Rev. Myers is an Episcopalian Priest and is the first pastor to represent the Episcopal denomination at the church. Previous pastors have represented the United Church of Christ from 2001-2007, The United Methodist Church 1988-2000, and The Presbyterian Church, USA from 1969-1988.

Rev. Myers served as Rector of the Church of the Good Shepherd and St. John the Evangelist in Milford, PA from 1980-1999. Her experience includes some unusual assignments such as spending three months on sabbatical in 1995 as a priest in the Church of South Africa in the Anglican Diocese of Kimberly and Kuruman and serving as a priest for the Episcopal Church in Navajoland in Arizona and New Mexico from 200-2002. Her background, talent, and marvelous sense of humor combine to produce interesting and invigorating dialogue. Join us to share Worship Service led by The Rev. Rev. Myers obtained her AB from Smith College in 1957 and her M. Div. from Episcopal Divinity School in 1962. She spent 13 years teaching religion in church schools and serving as Dean of Women/Students in secondary schools and a junior college. She was ordained Deacon in the Episcopal Church in 1974 and Priest in 1977. She retired from full-time ministry in 1999 and has accepted Interim assignments since then. She is currently a resident of Heath Village in Hackettstown.
